



The St. Joseph County Grange Fair has been fortunate over the last several years in having the use of Golf Carts on the grounds during Fair Week. Most Fairs throughout Michigan do not. Our grounds compared to most are much larger and the use of carts seems to ease the burden of animal maintenance and other activities.

Over the years the number of carts brought to the fair has increased and with that the number of instances of accidents, some with injury, as well as complaints from fair goers themselves.

After lengthy discussion the Fair's Board of Directors would like to keep the use of carts on the grounds, if possible, going forward. To do this we need to take a better stance enforcing the cart policy during Fair Week. Without everyone who uses a cart at the fair's cooperation, we could lose the ability to allow them in the future. Everyone who uses a cart during fair is provided a copy of the policy. We ask that it be followed, as it was written for the benefit of all fair goers and participants. While a minor violation of the policy during fair week may result in just a warning, repeated offenses and major violations will result in expulsion of the cart from the grounds.

The cart policy has not changed, if you've had carts here in the past you already know it. You will still need your proof of liability insurance. We however want all cart users to be aware that the cost to bring your cart to the 2019 fair is fifty dollars (\$50.00). We are a seven (7) day fair and this equates to seven dollars and fourteen cents (\$7.14) per day.

The Fair Board wants everyone who participates or attends the Centerville Fair to have a memorable experience for years to come. We will see you in September.
